- 12 (1) Department means the Department of Health and Human Services;
- 13 (2) State institution means the state hospitals at Lincoln<sub> $\tau$ </sub> and
- 14 Norfolk, the and Hastings Regional Center, the Beatrice State
- 15 Developmental Center, and such other institutions as may hereafter be
- 16 established by the Legislature for the care and treatment of persons with
- 17 a mental disorder or persons with an intellectual disability;
- 18 (3) Relative means the spouse of a patient or, if the patient has no
- 19 spouse and is under the age of majority at the time he or she is
- 20 admitted, the parents of a patient in a state institution; and
- 21 (4) Parents means either or both of a patient's natural parents
- 22 unless such patient has been legally adopted by other parents, in which
- 23 case parents means either or both of the adoptive parents.
