- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the designated health information exchange;
- to amend section 81-6,125, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 3 2020; to require provision of clinical information by health care
- 4 facilities and health care payors; to repeal the original section;
- 5 and to declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 81-6,125, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 81-6,125 (1) The purpose of the Population Health Information Act
- 4 is to designate a health information exchange to provide the data
- 5 infrastructure needed to assist in creating a healthier Nebraska and
- 6 operating the electronic health records initiative.
- 7 (2) The designated health information exchange shall:
- 8 $\frac{\text{(a)}}{\text{(1)}}$ Aggregate clinical information from health care entities
- 9 needed to support the operation of the medical assistance program under
- 10 the Medical Assistance Act;
- 11 $\underline{\text{(b)}}$ (2) Act as the designated entity for purposes of access to and
- 12 analysis of health data;
- 13 (c) (3) Collect and analyze data for purposes of informing the
- 14 Legislature, the department, health care providers, and health care
- 15 entities as to the cost of, access to, and quality of health care in
- 16 Nebraska;
- 17 $\underline{\text{(d)}}$ (4) Act as a collector and reporter of public health data for
- 18 registry submissions, electronic laboratory reporting, immunization
- 19 reporting, and syndromic surveillance from an electronic health record,
- 20 which does not include claims data; and
- 21 (e) (5) Enable any health care provider or health care entity to
- 22 access information available within the designated health information
- 23 exchange to evaluate and monitor care and treatment of a patient in
- 24 accordance with the privacy and security provisions set forth in the
- 25 federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996,
- 26 Public Law 104-191.
- 27 (3) On or before September 30, 2021, each health care facility as
- 28 defined in section 71-413 shall participate in the designated health
- 29 <u>information exchange through sharing of clinical information. Such</u>
- 30 clinical information shall include patient health information as
- 31 determined by policies adopted by the Health Information Technology

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1 Board. Any connection established by July 1, 2021, between a health care

- 2 <u>facility</u> and the designated health information exchange to facilitate
- 3 <u>such participation shall be at no cost to the participating health care</u>
- 4 <u>facility</u>.
- 5 (4) On or before September 30, 2021, each health care payor as
- 6 <u>defined in section 25-21,247 shall participate in the designated health</u>
- 7 information exchange through sharing of information. Such information
- 8 shall be determined by policies adopted by the Health Information
- 9 <u>Technology Board</u>.
- 10 Sec. 2. Original section 81-6,125, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 11 Supplement, 2020, is repealed.
- 12 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 13 passed and approved according to law.
