- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Department of Health and Human
 Services; to direct the department to apply for grants to establish
 and maintain a health care insurance claims and payment information
 data base.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>The Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services</u>
2	shall apply for grants to states from the United States Department of
3	Health and Human Services under the Consolidated Appropriations Act,
4	<u>2021, Public Law 116-260, to establish and maintain a data base to</u>
5	publish claims and payment information from health insurers.
6	Sec. 2. Upon obtaining federal grant money under section 1 of this
7	act, the Department of Health and Human Services in conjunction with the
8	<u>University of Nebraska Medical Center College of Public Health shall</u>
9	<u>plan, establish, and maintain a data base of claims and payment</u>
10	information from health insurers. The data base shall be accessible from
11	the department's web site. The uses of the data base may include, but are
12	not limited to:
13	(1) Tracking information about health care utilization, quality, and
14	<u>cost;</u>
15	(2) Monitoring the success and efficiency of initiatives to improve
16	health care and population health;
17	(3) Analyzing variations in health care costs, quality, utilization,
18	and illness burden based on geographical areas or populations;
19	<u>(4) Supporting quality improvement efforts to compare provider</u>
20	performance; and
21	(5) Promoting accountability for state medicaid contracts to assure
22	the effectiveness of managed care and providing an objective way for the
23	state to monitor the performance of medicaid-managed care or value-based
24	purchasing contracts.

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
