## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 498**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to broadband services; to require the Public
- 2 Service Commission to implement a broadband service testing and
- 3 mapping program as prescribed.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Public Service Commission shall implement a
- 2 <u>broadband service testing and mapping program designed to provide</u>
- 3 <u>information on broadband availability and broadband speeds received by</u>
- 4 telecommunications service subscribers in Nebraska.
- 5 (2) The commission may contract with third-party contractors to
- 6 <u>test</u>, <u>validate</u>, <u>and map broadband service availability and speeds for</u>
- 7 purposes of the program. As a condition for receiving Nebraska
- 8 <u>Telecommunications Universal Service Fund support, each</u>
- 9 <u>telecommunications company receiving universal service support shall be</u>
- 10 required to submit data to the commission for testing under the program.
- 11 (3) The program may utilize independent computing devices that are
- 12 <u>first-in-line to the telecommunications service provider connection</u>,
- 13 <u>independent of all other subscriber-premise personal equipment used for</u>
- 14 measuring broadband speeds, which can test and validate broadband service
- 15 availability and speeds at the telecommunications service subscriber's
- 16 premises, with the subscriber's prior consent.
- 17 (4) The commission shall utilize the program to provide validation
- 18 information in a public broadband map, and may share such map with the
- 19 Federal Communications Commission for any purpose the Public Service
- 20 Commission deems necessary.
- 21 (5) The data collected and map developed shall be made available to
- 22 the public on the commission's web site.
