- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to emergency response; to adopt the Critical
- 2 Infrastructure Utility Worker Protection Act; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 5 of this act shall be known and may be

- 2 <u>cited as the Critical Infrastructure Utility Worker Protection Act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 2. For purposes of the Critical Infrastructure Utility Worker
- 4 Protection Act, unless the context otherwise requires:
- 5 (1) Civil defense emergency has the same meaning as in section
- 6 81-829.39;
- 7 (2) Critical infrastructure utility worker means any person employed
- 8 <u>in the state by a utility to engineer, construct, repair, maintain,</u>
- 9 manage, and operate a utility system, including operations relating to
- 10 the reliability, resilience, safety, security, environmental health, and
- 11 physical and cyber security of such utility system;
- 12 <u>(3) Disaster has the same meaning as in section 81-829.39;</u>
- 13 (4) Emergency has the same meaning as in section 81-829.39;
- 14 (5) Priority access means access at least equal to that provided to
- 15 <u>hospital</u> and <u>medical</u> personnel, law enforcement personnel, or other
- 16 emergency responders;
- 17 <u>(6) Utility means any legal entity, including a political</u>
- 18 subdivision, that owns or operates a utility system, or any part thereof,
- 19 <u>in this state; and</u>
- 20 <u>(7) Utility system means the physical and cyber assets and</u>
- 21 infrastructure used in providing utility services to wholesale or retail
- 22 customers. Utility system includes electrical, gas, water, steam, sewage,
- 23 and telecommunications services.
- 24 Sec. 3. The purposes of the Critical Infrastructure Utility Worker
- 25 Protection Act are to:
- 26 (1) Provide for protection of critical infrastructure utility
- 27 workers during any civil defense emergency, disaster, or emergency;
- 28 (2) Provide priority access to personal protective equipment,
- 29 medical screening, testing, preventative health services, medical
- 30 treatment, and the administration of vaccines for critical infrastructure
- 31 utility workers in the event of an emergency involving a severe threat to

- 1 human health; and
- 2 (3) Authorize federal and state financial aid for critical
- 3 <u>infrastructure utility workers during any civil defense emergency,</u>
- 4 disaster, or emergency involving a severe threat to human health.
- 5 Sec. 4. Utilities shall maintain a list of critical infrastructure
- 6 <u>utility workers by position description without listing individual names.</u>
- 7 The list shall not be deemed a public record subject to disclosure
- 8 pursuant to sections 84-712 to 84-712.09, but shall be made available to
- 9 <u>the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency upon request.</u>
- 10 Sec. 5. <u>In the event of any civil defense emergency, disaster, or</u>
- 11 emergency involving a severe threat to human health, the Governor shall:
- 12 <u>(1) Ensure that critical infrastructure utility workers are provided</u>
- 13 priority access to personal protective equipment, medical screening,
- 14 testing, preventive health services, medical treatment, and the
- 15 administration of vaccines approved by the federal Food and Drug
- 16 Administration;
- 17 (2) Provide funds from the Governor's Emergency Program established
- 18 pursuant to section 81-829.42 to assure the adequate protection and care
- 19 of critical infrastructure utility workers; and
- 20 (3) Take all necessary measures to provide available federal funds
- 21 for the adequate protection and care of critical infrastructure utility
- 22 workers.
- 23 Sec. 6. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 24 passed and approved according to law.
