LEGISLATIVE BILL 529A

Introduced by Walz, 15.

Read first time May 04, 2021

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred
3 Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021; to outright repeal section
4 49, Legislative Bill 380, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First
5 Session, 2021; and to declare an emergency.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,870,237 from the
2 Behavioral Training Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$1,935,695 from the
3 Behavioral Training Cash Fund for FY2022-23 to the State Department of
4 Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
5 Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session,
6 2021.

7 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
8 \$1,870,237 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
9 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
10 FY2022-23 \$1,935,695 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used
11 for such purpose.

12 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
13 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
14 section.

15 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$196,867 from the College
16 Credit Testing Fee Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$203,757 from the
17 College Credit Testing Fee Cash Fund for FY2022-23 to the State
18 Department of Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the
19 provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature,
20 First Session, 2021.

21 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
22 \$134,765 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
23 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
24 FY2022-23 \$140,622 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for
25 such purpose.

26 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
27 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$32,489
28 for FY2021-22 or \$33,789 for FY2022-23.

29 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$590,601 from the Expanded
30 Learning Opportunity Grant Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$611,272 from the
31 Expanded Learning Opportunity Grant Fund for FY2022-23 to the State

1 Department of Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the
2 provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature,
3 First Session, 2021.

4 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
5 \$466,395 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
6 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
7 FY2022-23 \$485,715 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for
8 such purpose.

9 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
10 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$64,979
11 for FY2021-22 or \$67,578 for FY2022-23.

12 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$295,301 from the Mental
13 Health Training Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$305,636 from the Mental
14 Health Training Cash Fund for FY2022-23 to the State Department of
15 Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
16 Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session,
17 2021.

18 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
19 \$295,301 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
20 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
21 FY2022-23 \$305,636 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for
22 such purpose.

23 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
24 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
25 section.

26 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$295,301 from the State
27 Department of Education Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$305,636 from the
28 State Department of Education Cash Fund for FY2022-23 to the State
29 Department of Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the
30 provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature,
31 First Session, 2021.

1 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
2 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
3 section.

4 Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$885,902 from the State
5 Department of Education Leadership Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and (2)
6 \$916,908 from the State Department of Education Leadership Cash Fund for
7 FY2022-23 to the State Department of Education, for Program 161, to aid
8 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred
9 Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

10 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
11 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$100,000
12 for FY2021-22 or \$105,000 for FY2022-23.

13 Sec. 7. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$98,434 from the State
14 Department of Education Technology Upgrade Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and
15 (2) \$101,879 from the State Department of Education Technology Upgrade
16 Cash Fund for FY2022-23 to the State Department of Education, for Program
17 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One
18 Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

19 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
20 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$30,000
21 for FY2021-22 or \$35,000 for FY2022-23.

22 Sec. 8. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$590,601 from the Nebraska
23 Education Improvement Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$611,272 from the
24 Nebraska Education Improvement Fund for FY2022-23 to the State Department
25 of Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
26 Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session,
27 2021.

28 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
29 \$559,551 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
30 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
31 FY2022-23 \$579,706 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for

1 such purpose.

2 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
3 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$16,244
4 for FY2021-22 or \$16,894 for FY2022-23.

5 Sec. 9. There is hereby appropriated the unexpended cash fund
6 balance in the Department of Education Innovative Grant Fund as of June
7 30, 2021 for FY2021-22 and (2) \$0 from the Department of Education
8 Innovative Grant Fund for FY2022-23 to the State Department of Education,
9 for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative
10 Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

11 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
12 the unexpended cash fund balance as of June 30, 2021, less \$100,000, Cash
13 Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.

14 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
15 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$42,689
16 for FY2021-22 or \$0 for FY2022-23.

17 Sec. 10. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$492,168 from the Access
18 College Early Scholarship Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$509,393 from
19 the Access College Early Scholarship Cash Fund for FY2022-23 to the
20 Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education, for Program 691, to
21 aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred
22 Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

23 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
24 \$492,168 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
25 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
26 FY2022-23 \$509,393 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for
27 such purpose.

28 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
29 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
30 section.

31 Sec. 11. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$393,734 from the Career-

1 Readiness and Dual-Credit Education Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and (2)
2 \$407,515 from the Career-Readiness and Dual-Credit Education Cash Fund
3 for FY2022-23 to the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education,
4 for Program 692, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative
5 Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

6 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
7 \$300,484 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
8 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
9 FY2022-23 \$314,065 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for
10 such purpose.

11 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
12 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$55,000
13 for FY2021-22 or \$56,100 for FY2022-23.

14 Sec. 12. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,476,503 from the
15 Excellence in Teaching Cash Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$1,528,180 from
16 the Excellence in Teaching Cash Fund for FY2022-23 to the Coordinating
17 Commission for Postsecondary Education, for Program 692, to aid in
18 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh
19 Legislature, First Session, 2021.

20 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
21 \$1,369,103 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
22 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
23 FY2022-23 \$1,419,282 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used
24 for such purpose.

25 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
26 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$45,000
27 for FY2021-22 or \$45,900 for FY2022-23.

28 Sec. 13. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$196,897 from the Door to
29 College Scholarship Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$203,757 from the Door to
30 College Scholarship Fund for FY2022-23 to the Coordinating Commission for
31 Postsecondary Education, for Program 692, to aid in carrying out the

1 provisions of Legislative Bill 529, One Hundred Seventh Legislature,
2 First Session, 2021.

3 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
4 \$196,897 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
5 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for
6 FY2022-23 \$203,757 Cash Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for
7 such purpose.

8 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
9 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
10 section.

11 Sec. 14. The following section is outright repealed: Section 49,
12 Legislative Bill 380, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session,
13 2021.

14 Sec. 15. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
15 passed and approved according to law.
