- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to provide for an
- 3 operator's license to remain valid while serving as an officer of
- 4 the foreign service of the United States; and to repeal the original
- 5 section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-4,121, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2 2020, is amended to read:

3 60-4,121 (1) ~~An~~ The operator's license of any person serving on
4 active duty, other than members of the National Guard or reserves
5 activated for training purposes only, outside the State of Nebraska as a
6 member of the United States Armed Forces, or the spouse of any such
7 person or a dependent of such member of the armed forces, shall be valid
8 during the such person's period of active duty and for not more than
9 sixty days immediately following the such person's date of separation
10 from service for: -

11 (a) A person serving on active duty, other than a member of the
12 National Guard or reserves activated for training purposes only, outside
13 the State of Nebraska as a member of the United States Armed Forces;

14 (b) An officer of the foreign service of the United States;

15 (c) The spouse of a person described in subdivision (a) or (b) of
16 this section; and

17 (d) The dependent of a person described in subdivision (a) or (b) of
18 this section.

19 (2) Each individual who is applying for renewal of his or her
20 operator's license shall submit his or her previous license to the
21 department personnel or, when the previous license is unavailable,
22 furnish proof of identification in accordance with section 60-484.
