- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 566, One Hundred
- 3 Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021; to provide for a transfer
- 4 of funds; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$25,000,000 from the
- 2 Shovel-Ready Capital Recovery and Investment Fund and \$75,000,000 from
- 3 federal funds for FY2021-22 and (2) \$0 for FY2022-23 to the Department of
- 4 Economic Development, for Program 603, to aid in carrying out the
- 5 provisions of Legislative Bill 566, One Hundred Seventh Legislature,
- 6 First Session, 2021.
- 7 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
- 8 <u>diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$59,460</u>
- 9 for FY2021-22 or \$60,010 for FY2022-23.
- There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
- 11 \$24,737,700 Cash Funds and \$75,000,000 Federal Funds for state aid, which
- 12 <u>shall only be used for such purpose.</u>
- Sec. 2. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$25,000,000 from the
- 14 General Fund to the Shovel-Ready Capital Recovery and Investment Fund on
- or after July 1, 2021, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by
- 16 the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 17 Administrative Services.
- 18 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 19 passed and approved according to law.
