- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to game and parks; to amend section 37-438,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to define terms
- 3 relating to annual and temporary park permits; and to repeal the
- 4 original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 37-438, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 37-438 (1) The commission shall devise annual, temporary, and
- 4 disabled veteran permits.
- 5 (2) The annual permit may be purchased by any person and shall be
- 6 valid through December 31 in the year for which the permit is issued. The
- 7 fee for the annual permit for a resident motor vehicle shall be not more
- 8 than thirty-five dollars per permit. The fee for the annual permit for a
- 9 nonresident motor vehicle shall not be less than the fee for a resident
- 10 motor vehicle and not more than sixty-five dollars. The commission shall
- 11 establish such fees by the adoption and promulgation of rules and
- 12 regulations.
- 13 (3) A temporary permit may be purchased by any person and shall be
- 14 valid until noon of the day following the date of issue. The fee for the
- 15 temporary permit for a resident motor vehicle shall be not more than
- 16 seven dollars. The fee for the temporary permit for a nonresident motor
- 17 vehicle shall be not more than twelve dollars. The commission shall
- 18 establish such fees by the adoption and promulgation of rules and
- 19 regulations. The commission may issue temporary permits which are either
- 20 valid for any area or valid for a single area.
- 21 (4)(a) A veteran who is a resident of Nebraska shall, upon
- 22 application and without payment of any fee, be issued one disabled
- 23 veteran permit for a resident motor vehicle if the veteran:
- 24 (i) Was discharged or separated with a characterization of honorable
- or general (under honorable conditions); and
- 26 (ii)(A) Is rated by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
- 27 as fifty percent or more disabled as a result of service in the armed
- 28 forces of the United States; or
- 29 (B) Is receiving a pension from the United States Department of
- 30 Veterans Affairs as a result of total and permanent disability, which
- 31 disability was not incurred in the line of duty in the military service.

- 1 (b) All disabled veteran permits issued pursuant to this subsection
- 2 shall be perpetual and shall become void only upon termination of
- 3 eligibility as provided in this subsection.
- 4 (c) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations
- 5 necessary to carry out this subsection.
- 6 (5) The commission may offer permits or combinations of permits at
- 7 temporarily reduced rates for specific events or during specified
- 8 timeframes.
- 9 (6) For purposes of this section, resident motor vehicle means a
- 10 motor vehicle registered and licensed in this state and nonresident motor
- 11 <u>vehicle means a motor vehicle registered or licensed in another state.</u>
