- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to provide for a pilot program to
- 2 study commercial air filters in classrooms as prescribed.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. (1) The State Department of Education shall develop and  
2 implement a pilot program to study the efficacy of commercial air filters  
3 in classrooms to remove common pollutants and particulate matter and  
4 their impact on academic and behavioral performance. The pilot program  
5 shall include fifty participating schools with six participating  
6 classrooms in each participating school. Fifty percent of the  
7 participating classrooms shall be randomly assigned to the control group.  
8 Upon conclusion of the study, the department shall electronically report  
9 the results to the Clerk of the Legislature and to the Education  
10 Committee of the Legislature.

11           (2) The State Board of Education may adopt and promulgate rules and  
12 regulations to carry out this section.
