Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 274 creates a promotional farmers market special designated license.

This bill applies to farm wineries, craft breweries, and micro-distilleries.

A farmers market is defined as “any common facility or area where producers or growers gather on a regular, recurring basis to sell fruits, vegetables, meats, and other farm products directly to consumers.”

The promotional farmer’s market special designated license will cost \$15 for an annual license.

The Nebraska Liquor Control Commission will grant or deny the license.

Local governing bodies will determine where a licensee will be allowed to operate.
