The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 355 makes five changes to various sections of statutes to remove unnecessary language or add clarifying language as identified by the State Court Administrator's office. These changes include: removing references to county payment of bonds for county judges and magistrates as these bonds are paid by the state; requires the service of summons in a replevin action to be served within three days of issuance; strikes language regarding small claims court filing forms and provides that the Supreme Court may prescribe the content of the forms; amends provisions on adoption records to remove a microfilm reference and refer to modern records retention statutes; and remove a reference to condemnation action deposits.
