The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

- Establishes Election Day, the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November in each even-numbered year, as a state holiday;
- Requires absentee, vote by mail, ballot return envelopes, pre-addressed to the election commissioner or county clerk, to be postage paid; and
- Updates the voter registration process for applicants for an operator's license or state identification card, who have met the legal requirements to vote, will automatically have their voter registration updated or be registered to vote.
