The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 660 proposes to amend the State Employees Collective Bargaining Act to clarify that certain employees in the University System and certain employees at State Colleges are able to petition the Commission of Industrial Relations for certification of exclusive bargaining representatives within bargaining units that are based on the campus where those employees are employed.

This change is necessary to ensure that affected employees are not required to seek statewide or system-wide certification, and it would only affect academic-administrative staff, including adjunct faculty.
