

LEGISLATIVE BILL 106A

Approved by the Governor April 7, 2021

Introduced by Friesen, 34.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 106, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021; and to declare an emergency.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$94,780 from the Operator's License Services System Replacement and Maintenance Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$97,197 from the Operator's License Services System Replacement and Maintenance Fund for FY2022-23 to the Department of Motor Vehicles, for Program 70, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 106, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$60,085 for FY2021-22 or \$61,287 for FY2022-23.

Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
