

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 1144A

Approved by the Governor April 19, 2022

Introduced by Friesen, 34.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1144, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022; and to declare an emergency.  
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$2,955,435 from federal funds for FY2022-23 and (2) \$2,850,022 from federal funds for FY2023-24 to the Public Service Commission, for Program 793, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1144, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$217,712 for FY2022-23 or \$222,065 for FY2023-24.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$324,875 from Federal Funds for FY2022-23 and (2) \$316,738 from Federal Funds for FY2023-24 to the Public Service Commission, for Program 793, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1144, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022. The Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, 42 U.S.C. 802, as amended.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$194,400 for FY2022-23 or \$198,288 for FY2023-24.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
