

LEGISLATIVE BILL 147A

Passed over the Governor's veto May 26, 2021.

Introduced by Kolterman, 24.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 147, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021; and to declare an emergency.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$750,000 from the Class V School Employees Retirement System Management Work Plan Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$4,275,893 from the Class V School Employees Retirement System Management Work Plan Fund for FY2022-23 to the Public Employees Retirement Board, for Program 41, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 147, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$0 for FY2021-22 or \$274,933 for FY2022-23.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$59,158 from the School Expense Fund for FY2021-22 and (2) \$54,700 from the School Expense Fund for FY2022-23 to the Public Employees Retirement Board, for Program 41, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 147, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$41,660 for FY2021-22 or \$42,077 for FY2022-23.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
