2 There is included in the amount shown for FY2023-24 \$112,353,248
3 Cash Funds which are hereby appropriated to provide twenty-four percent
4 of foundation aid to public school districts pursuant to the Tax Equity
5 and Educational Opportunities Support Act. There is included in the
6 amount shown for FY2024-25 \$113,145,292 Cash Funds which are hereby
7 appropriated to provide twenty-four percent of foundation aid to public
8 school districts pursuant to the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities
9 Support Act.

10 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$235,724,424
11 General Funds and \$199,041,052 Cash Funds provided as state aid for
12 FY2023-24 for special education reimbursement. There is included in the
13 amount shown for this program \$235,724,424 General Funds and \$206,007,489
14 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for special education
15 reimbursement.

16 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$1,465,500
17 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$1,465,500 General
18 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 to carry out the provisions of
19 subsection (2) of section 79-734.

20 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$10,161,395
21 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$10,161,395 General
22 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for core services for
23 educational service units.

24 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$3,170,927
25 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$3,170,927 General
26 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for technology infrastructure
27 for educational service units.

28 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$281,654
29 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$281,654 General
30 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for distance education aid to
31 educational service units.

1 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$617,898
2 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$617,898 General
3 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the school breakfast
4 program.

5 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$392,032
6 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$392,032 General
7 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the school lunch program.

8 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$90,000
9 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$90,000 General
10 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the Summer Food Service
11 Program.

12 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$214,664
13 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$214,664 General
14 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for adult basic education
15 programs.

16 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$750,000
17 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$750,000 General
18 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for aid to institutions
19 offering high school equivalency programs.

20 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$3,619,357
21 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$3,619,357 General
22 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for early childhood education
23 projects.

24 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$7,500,000
25 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$7,500,000 General
26 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the Early Childhood
27 Education Grant Program for at-risk children from birth to age three. It
28 is the intent of the Legislature that a maximum of five percent of
29 General Funds appropriated each fiscal year for the Early Childhood
30 Education Grant Program for at-risk children from birth to age three may
31 be used for evaluation and technical assistance.

1 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$100,000
2 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$100,000 General
3 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for scholarships for early
4 childhood education providers.

5 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$69,000
6 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$69,000 General
7 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for incentive bonuses for
8 providers of child care and early childhood education programs.

9 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$400,000
10 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$400,000 General
11 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the Nurturing Healthy
12 Behaviors program.

13 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$470,000
14 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$470,000 General
15 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for learning community aid.

16 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$2,342,962
17 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$2,342,962 General
18 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for programs for learners with
19 high ability.

20 There is included in the amount shown for this program for FY2023-24
21 \$5,116,000 Cash Funds as state aid, to be distributed between secondary
22 and postsecondary schools according to the formula used for federal
23 Perkins funds as such formula existed on January 1, 2023. Up to \$306,960
24 of this amount may be used for administrative purposes. Each school
25 district shall receive no less than \$7,500. There is included in the
26 amount shown for this program for FY2024-25 \$5,116,000 Cash Funds as
27 state aid, to be distributed between secondary and postsecondary schools
28 according to the formula used for federal Perkins funds as such formula
29 existed on January 1, 2023. Up to \$306,960 of this amount may be used for
30 administrative purposes. Each school district shall receive no less than
31 \$7,500.

1 There is included in the amount shown for this program for FY2023-24
2 \$200,000 Cash Funds as state aid, to be evenly distributed between the
3 career education student organizations. Up to \$50,000 of this amount may
4 be used for administrative purposes. There is included in the amount
5 shown for this program for FY2024-25 \$200,000 Cash Funds as state aid, to
6 be evenly distributed between the career education student organizations.
7 Up to \$50,000 of this amount may be used for administrative purposes.

8 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2023.

9 Sec. 3. Original section 50, Legislative Bill 814, One Hundred
10 Eighth Legislature, First Session, 2023, is repealed.

11 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
12 passed and approved according to law.
