Nebraska's Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) continues to work successfully with Netsmart (the state's EVV vendor). As a result, adoption continues to trend upward. Please see the latest EVV statistics for 2022:

In a letter dated July 27, 2022, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) notified DHHS that the EVV module was certified. CMS approved the State's request for certification retroactive to the implementation date of December 13, 2020. As a result, DHHS has been approved for 75 percent Federal Financial Participation (FFP) retroactive to the first day in the calendar quarter following the project implementation date. DHHS provides quarterly performance reporting to CMS in support of ongoing funding.
