SUBJECT: ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2022: NUMBER OF OPERATOR'S LICENSES SUSPENDED UNDER THE LICENSE SUSPENSION ACT, LB752 (LAWS 1997)

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 43-3326, I am required by law to issue a report to the Legislature on or before January 31st of each year which discloses the number of operators' licenses which were suspended and the number which were erroneously suspended and restored as a result of the License Suspension Act, LB752 (Laws 1997).

Report for 2022

Number of Operator's Licenses Suspended: 4,152

Number of Operator's Licenses Erroneously Suspended: 0

Number of Operator's Licenses Restored: 3,827

The Department suspends those licenses, which have been certified and sent to us by the Department of Health and Human Services. There were 4,467 certifications for non CDL holders, 93 certifications for CDL holders, received from DHHS for 2022. (LB 752 went into effect on Sept. 13, 1997).
