ROOM CONFINEMENT SUMARRY REPORT FOR 1/1/2023 - 3/31/2023

Overview

The Lancaster County Youth Services Center reports all instances of room confinement that total to over 1 hour in a 24-hour period. For example, if a youth is placed in their room for a time out for 30 minutes, in their room for our safety check for 45 minutes, then there are 2 instances for the day that total over 1 hour.

The quarantine period for COVID was removed in late March 2023. This will significantly impact future reports, as most of our reporting hours are directly related to the quarantine precautions and the reduction of communicable diseases.
