Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 12 proposes the establishment of the School District Property Tax Relief Act, starting in the tax year 2024. This act would provide \$560,700,000 million in relief, with an annual increase of \$30 million starting in 2025. The collection fee for costs would offset the reduction in property taxes collected for the school district, resulting in no fiscal impact on the county.

The bill incorporates some provisions of LB 388 (2024) with modifications. Specifically, the bill repeals the income tax credits for property taxes paid to schools under the Nebraska Property Tax Incentive Act, beginning in tax year 2024.

Estimated General Fund revenue gained by repealing the income tax credit is \$565,135,000 million in FY25 and \$649,373,000 million in FY26. The amounts required for the new school district property tax credit are assumed to be transferred to the newly created cash fund from the General Fund.
