Section 3 allows the Public Service Commission to set the amount of securities required for grain dealers. The amount shall not be less than thirty-five thousand dollars and not more than one million dollars.

Additionally, the bill refines the term “Grain” for the Grain Dealer Act and the Grain Warehouse Act.
