Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 328 requires the Attorney General to establish the Office of Liaison for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Persons. The office shall be staffed with a full-time specialist who shall serve as the liaison among local, state, tribal, and federal entities involved in reporting or investigating such cases.

The Attorney General estimates the cost of hiring the required specialist will be \$96,049 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$99,504 in fiscal year 2024-25. The Attorney General does not provide an estimate for any related start-up costs (e.g., computer, desk, etc.) nor possible travel expenses. It is assumed that any costs in addition to the salary and benefit estimates provided will be absorbed within current budgetary resources. There is no basis to disagree with the Attorney General's estimate.

The Nebraska Indian Commission estimates \$10,000 per year to address support issues related to the duties contained in LB 328. This would include items such as travel and mileage reimbursements. This estimate appears to be reasonable.

While the above-mentioned costs are associated with LB 328, funding for the position in the Attorney General's Office was included in the Mainline Budget Bill (LB 814 - 2023). Since the funding is in place, and the position is filled, the Attorney General updated the fiscal impact to reflect a new cost of \$0. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate because no other costs were identified.

The Nebraska Indian Commission did not respond to a request for updated fiscal impact. The \$10,000 they originally identified for LB 328 has not been provided. Presumably, that amount is still needed, if LB 328 moves forward.
