**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

This bill modifies requirements for child care licensing and child care facilities to note that no license shall be prohibited from obtaining a dual license for the purpose of complying with attendance requirements.

As amended, the bill no longer prohibits political subdivisions from establishing residency requirements for a family child care home. The bill also requires the Department of Health and Human Services to report on local rules and regulations rather than zoning and ordinances.

Modifying rules and regulations will require staff time which can be absorbed within current agency appropriations. No fiscal impact.
