Floor Debate July 31, 2024

KELLY: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the fifth day of the One Hundred Eighth Legislature, First Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Moser. Please rise.

MOSER: Dear Lord, give us wisdom to make good decisions and to see the consequences of our decisions. Give us courage to act on those ideas that you inspire in us. Give us the heart to care about how it affects everyone in our state. Also, bless everyone in this building with good health, both mental and physical. In your name we pray. Amen.

KELLY: I recognize Senator Ibach for the Pledge of Allegiance.
