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GENERAL FILE: CONSENT CALENDAR

The following rules apply to Consent Calendar:

- 1) If any five members of the Legislature object to the bill being considered on Consent Calendar, please advise the Clerk in writing. Such requests must be filed with the Clerk prior to the reading of the bill, at this stage of consideration, on the bill to be removed.
- 2) Upon either the completion of debate or the expiration of 15 minutes, whichever comes first, a vote shall be taken to advance the bill and on any pending motions or amendments pursuant to Rule 5, Section 6(d).
- 3) Any amendment adopted, other than the standing committee amendment, which adds new subject matter to the bill will result in the bill not being scheduled at the next stage of debate.

LB 120 *(Hardin)* Provide an exception regarding release of a digital image under the Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act

LB 614 *(Andersen)* Provide for exemptions from regulatory authority of cities of the first and second class and villages for certain farm buildings

LB 385 *(Storer)* Change provisions relating to the Uniform Deceptive Trade Practices Act

LB 69 *(Spivey)* Change meeting requirements and provide duties for the Commission on African American Affairs

LB 470 *(Bosn)* Provide for attorneys to make unsworn declarations under penalty of perjury in lieu of sworn declarations
