- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to require display of the state
- 2 motto and the national motto; and to authorize contributions.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- Section 1. (1) On and after the effective date of this act, each
- 2 <u>school board shall prominently display the national motto of the United</u>
- 3 States, "In God We Trust", and the state motto of Nebraska, "Equality
- 4 <u>Under the Law", written legibly in English on a poster or plaque no less</u>
- 5 than eight and one-half by eleven inches in size, in each classroom or in
- 6 <u>another prominent place in each school building where each student is</u>
- 7 <u>able to see and read it each day school is in session.</u>
- 8 (2) A school board may accept contributions to defray the costs of
- 9 <u>implementing this section</u>.
