- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county records; to amend section 23-3211,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for withholding the
- 3 residential address of a county treasurer from the public; and to
- 4 repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 **Section 1.** Section 23-3211, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
2 amended to read:

3 23-3211 (1) Unless requested in writing, the county assessor, ~~and~~
4 register of deeds, and county treasurer shall withhold from the public
5 the residential address of a law enforcement officer, a member of the
6 Nebraska National Guard acting pursuant to subdivision (3) of section
7 55-182, or a judge who applies to the county assessor in the county of
8 his or her residence. The application shall be in a form prescribed by
9 the county assessor and shall include the applicant's name and address
10 and the parcel identification number for his or her residential address.
11 A law enforcement officer shall include in the application his or her law
12 enforcement identification number. A member of the Nebraska National
13 Guard shall include in the application proof of his or her status as a
14 member, in a manner prescribed by the county assessor. A judge shall
15 include in the application the name of the specific court of which he or
16 she is a judge. The county assessor shall notify the register of deeds
17 and county treasurer regarding the receipt of a complete application. The
18 county assessor, ~~and the register of deeds, and county treasurer~~ shall
19 withhold the address of a law enforcement officer, member of the Nebraska
20 National Guard, or judge who complies with this section for five years
21 after receipt of a complete application. The officer, member, or judge
22 may renew his or her application every five years upon submission of an
23 updated application.

24 (2) For purposes of this section, judge includes the judge or
25 magistrate judge of any court located in this state, including any county
26 court, any district court, the Court of Appeals, the Nebraska Workers'
27 Compensation Court, any separate juvenile court, the Supreme Court, and
28 any federal court.

29 **Sec. 2.** Original section 23-3211, Reissue Revised Statutes of
30 Nebraska, is repealed.
