**Section 1.** Section 60-3,191, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2024, is amended to read:
- 3 60-3,191 (1) In addition to any other fee required under the Motor
- 4 Vehicle Registration Act, a fee for registration of each motor vehicle
- 5 powered by an alternative fuel shall be charged. The fee shall be:
- 6 <u>(a) For one hundred fifty dollars, except that for</u> a motorcycle or
- 7 plug-in hybrid electric vehicle, the fee shall be seventy-five dollars; -
- 8 (b) For any commercially registered alternative fuel vehicle having
- 9 <u>a gross weight of more than seven thousand five hundred pounds, three</u>
- 10 times the applicable fee for other motor vehicles powered by an
- 11 <u>alternative fuel as described in subdivision (1)(c) of this section; or</u>
- (c) For any other motor vehicle powered by an alternative fuel, one
- 13 <u>hundred fifty dollars.</u>
- 14 (2) The fee shall be collected by the county treasurer and remitted
- 15 to the State Treasurer for credit to the Highway Trust Fund.
