- **Section 1.** Section 76-1446, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 76-1446 (1) Trial of the action for possession shall be held not
- 4 less than ten nor more than fourteen days after the issuance of the
- 5 summons, unless additional time is granted pursuant to court order. The
- 6 action shall be tried by the court without a jury. If the plaintiff
- 7 serves the summons in the manner provided in section 76-1442.01, the
- 8 action shall proceed as other actions for possession except that a money
- 9 judgment shall not be granted for the plaintiff.
- 10 (2) If judgment is rendered against the defendant for the
- 11 restitution of the premises, the court shall declare the forfeiture of
- 12 the rental agreement, and shall, at the request of the plaintiff or his
- 13 or her attorney, issue a writ of restitution, directing the constable or
- 14 sheriff to restore possession of the premises to the plaintiff on a
- 15 specified date not less more than ten days after issuance of the writ of
- 16 restitution. The court may order the writ of restitution to be executed
- 17 <u>on a date less than ten days after its issuance only upon:</u>
- 18 <u>(a) A showing that the defendant poses a true and imminent threat to</u>
- 19 the safety of other tenants, the landlord, or the landlord's employees or
- 20 <u>agents; or</u>
- 21 (b) The informed and express agreement of the parties.
- 22 (3) The plaintiff shall comply with the Disposition of Personal
- 23 Property Landlord and Tenant Act and subsection (5) of section 76-1414 in
- 24 the removal of personal property remaining on the premises at the time
- 25 possession of the premises is restored.
