- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulation
- 2 Act; to amend sections 86-111.01 and 86-124, Reissue Revised
- 3 Statutes of Nebraska; to redefine a term; to change provisions
- 4 relating to nonregulated activities; and to repeal the original
- 5 sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- Section 1. Section 86-111.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 86-111.01 Internet-protocol-enabled service or IP-enabled service
- 4 means any service, capability, functionality, or application, including
- 5 <u>broadband Internet access service as defined in 47 C.F.R. 8.1, as such</u>
- 6 <u>section existed on January 1, 2025, provided using Internet protocol, or</u>
- 7 any successor protocol, that enables a service user to send or receive a
- 8 communication in Internet protocol format, including, but not limited to,
- 9 voice, data, or video.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 86-124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 86-124 (1) The commission shall not regulate the following:
- 13 (a) One-way broadcast or cable television transmission of television
- 14 or radio signals;
- 15 (b) Mobile radio services, radio paging services, and wireless
- 16 telecommunications service;
- 17 (c) Interexchange services; and
- 18 (d) Internet-protocol-enabled service and voice over Internet
- 19 protocol service, including rates, service or contract terms, conditions,
- 20 or requirements for entry for such service.
- 21 (2) The regulation of broadband Internet access service as defined
- 22 in 47 C.F.R. 8.1, as such section existed on January 1, 2025, shall be
- 23 <u>vested with the Federal Communications Commission and no state agency,</u>
- 24 board, or commission or political subdivision of this state shall enact,
- 25 adopt, or enforce any law, rule, regulation, or ordinance the effect of
- 26 which would be to impose any regulation barred by subdivision (1)(d) of
- 27 this section.
- 28 (3) (2) This section shall not affect or modify:
- 29 (a) The enforcement of criminal or civil laws, including, but not
- 30 limited to, laws concerning consumer protection and unfair or deceptive
- 31 trade practices which apply generally to the conduct of business;

- 1 (b)(i) Any entity's obligations or rights or commission authority
- 2 under section 86-122 and under 47 U.S.C. 251 and 252, as such sections
- 3 existed on January 1, 2019, and (ii) any carrier-to-carrier tariff rates,
- 4 service quality standards, interconnection agreements, or other
- 5 obligations for which the commission has jurisdiction under state or
- 6 federal law;
- 7 (c) Any requirement to contribute to any fund administered by the
- 8 commission authorized by the Enhanced Wireless 911 Services Act or the
- 9 Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act;
- 10 (d) Any commission jurisdiction over intrastate switched access
- 11 rates, terms, and conditions, including the resolution of disputes
- 12 arising from, and implementation of federal and state law with respect
- 13 to, intercarrier compensation;
- (e) The eligibility and requirements for the receipt of funds from
- 15 the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund and the rules,
- 16 regulations, and orders under the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal
- 17 Service Fund Act or the receipt of funds from the federal universal
- 18 service fund, regardless of the unregulated status of the provider's
- 19 service under this section;
- 20 (f) Any entity's rights and obligations with respect to (i)
- 21 registration under section 86-125, (ii) the use of public streets, roads,
- 22 highways, and rights-of-way, or (iii) a certificate of public convenience
- 23 and necessity or a permit; and
- 24 (g) The commission's authority under section 86-1029.04; and -
- 25 (h) Any authority delegated to the commission or to any state
- 26 <u>agency, including, but not limited to, the Nebraska Broadband Office, to</u>
- 27 <u>administer a federal or state broadband grant program under a federal or</u>
- 28 state statute, rule, or order.
