- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating
- 3 to legislative approval of an indication of intent to incorporate
- 4 land into the state park system; to harmonize provisions; and to
- 5 repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 37-342, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 37-342 The commission may enter into long-term leases, lease-
- 4 purchase agreements, or other agreements with private or governmental
- 5 agencies for the control and use of real estate for state park system
- 6 purposes. Except as authorized in section 37-907, the commission shall
- 7 not provide a local governmental subdivision or agency thereof with an
- 8 indication of intent to incorporate into the state park system any land
- 9 or facilities owned or developed by such subdivision or agency unless the
- 10 indication of intent is first approved by the Legislature or, if the
- 11 <u>Legislature is not in session, the Executive Board of the Legislative</u>
- 12 <u>Council</u>. When seeking such approval, the commission shall provide the
- 13 Legislature or, if the Legislature is not in session, the Executive Board
- 14 of the Legislative Council with the estimated fiscal impact of the
- 15 incorporation, including the extent to which the costs of the
- 16 incorporation can reasonably be expected to be paid from cash funds and
- 17 the extent to which the costs will likely be required to be paid from
- 18 General Fund appropriations.
- 19 Sec. 2. Original section 37-342, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 20 Nebraska, is repealed.
