- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to roads; to amend sections 39-1722, 39-1724,
- 2 and 39-1725, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section
- 3 39-1410, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2024; to change
- 4 provisions relating to section lines and vacation or abandonment of
- 5 public roads; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
- 6 sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 39-1410, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2024, is amended to read:
- 3 39-1410 (1) The section lines are hereby declared, but are not
- 4 required, to be public roads in each county in the state.
- 5 (2) The and, the county board of any county may, whenever the public
- 6 good requires it, open such roads on section lines without any
- 7 preliminary survey and cause them to be worked in the same manner as
- 8 other public roads. ÷
- 9 (3) Any Provided, any damages claimed by reason of any such road
- 10 shall be appraised and allowed in the manner provided by law.
- 11 (4)(a) The county board shall cause existing government corners
- 12 along such line to be perpetuated by:
- 13 (i) Causing causing to be planted monuments of some durable
- 14 material, with suitable witnesses: τ and
- (ii) Causing causing a record to be made of such monuments.
- 16 <u>(b) If the same and, if government corners are lost or obliterated,</u>
- 17 the county board shall cause the corners to be located in the manner
- 18 provided in sections 23-1907 and 23-1908 the manual of instruction for
- 19 government surveys.
- 20 <u>(c)</u> The county board shall cause <u>any</u> such work <u>to be done under this</u>
- 21 <u>section</u> to be performed by the county surveyor or, if there is no county
- 22 surveyor in the county, by some other competent professional land
- 23 surveyor.
- Sec. 2. Section 39-1722, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 26 39-1722 (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section,
- 27 <u>the</u> The county board of any county may by resolution, when it deems the
- 28 public interest may require vacation or abandonment of a public road of
- 29 the county, direct the county highway superintendent or in counties
- 30 having no highway superintendent then such person as the board may direct
- 31 to study the use being made of such public road and to submit in writing

- 1 to the county board within thirty days, a report upon the study made and
- 2 the his or her recommendation of the directed superintendent or person as
- 3 to such the vacation or abandonment. Such thereof. Said resolution and
- 4 report shall be retained in the office of the county clerk as a part of
- 5 the permanent public records of the county board. $\dot{\tau}$
- 6 (2) The Provided, that the county board of any county shall not
- 7 require vacation or abandonment of any public road or any part of such
- 8 road thereof which is within the area of the zoning jurisdiction of a
- 9 city of the metropolitan, primary, or first class without the prior
- 10 approval of the governing body of such city.
- 11 (3)(a) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the
- 12 county board of any county may by resolution propose to vacate or abandon
- 13 a public road that was previously declared a public road pursuant to
- 14 section 39-1410 as such section existed prior to the effective date of
- 15 this act if it determines such vacation or abandonment is in the interest
- 16 of the public.
- 17 <u>(b) No study is required to be conducted for a vacation or</u>
- 18 <u>abandonment under this subsection.</u>
- 19 Sec. 3. Section 39-1724, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 20 amended to read:
- 21 39-1724 <u>(1)(a) The</u> Upon receipt of the report, as provided in
- 22 section 39-1722, the county board shall adopt a resolution fixing the
- 23 time, date, and place for a public hearing on the issue of vacating or
- 24 <u>abandoning a public road when:</u> . Such
- 25 <u>(i) The county board receives the report described in section</u>
- 26 <u>39-1722; or</u>
- 27 <u>(ii) The county board by resolution proposes to vacate or abandon a</u>
- 28 <u>public road that was previously declared a public road pursuant to</u>
- 29 <u>section 39-1410 as such section existed prior to the effective date of</u>
- 30 this act.
- 31 (b) The resolution fixing the time, date, and place for the public

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- 1 hearing shall contain a clear and unambiguous description of the road to
- 2 be vacated or abandoned.
- 3 (2) The county board shall cause such resolution to be published
- 4 once a week for three consecutive weeks in a legal newspaper published in
- 5 the county or, if none is published in the county, in a legal newspaper
- 6 of general circulation in the county.
- 7 (3)(a) Whenever possible the <u>county</u> board shall cause copies <u>of such</u>
- 8 <u>resolution</u> to be served by either registered or certified mail upon:
- 9 <u>(i) The</u> the owners of land abutting on or adjacent to the road to be
- 10 vacated or abandoned; and
- 11 <u>(ii) The upon the planning and public works directors of a city of</u>
- 12 the metropolitan, primary, or first class when such road or any part
- 13 thereof is within the area of the zoning jurisdiction of such city.
- 14 <u>(b) Such copies shall be mailed</u> by mailing the same to the last-
- 15 known address of each person described in subdivision (a) of this
- 16 <u>subsection owner</u> not less than two weeks in advance of the hearing.
- 17 Sec. 4. Section 39-1725, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 39-1725 (1) After the public hearing described in section 39-1724,
- 20 the county board shall, by resolution at its next meeting or as soon
- 21 thereafter as may be practicable, vacate or abandon or refuse vacation or
- 22 abandonment, as in the judgment of the board the public good may require.
- 23 (2) Vacation and abandonment shall not be ordered except upon vote
- 24 of two-thirds of all members of the county board and the prior approval
- 25 of the governing body of a city of the metropolitan, primary, or first
- 26 class has been obtained when any public road or any part thereof is
- 27 within the area of the zoning jurisdiction of such city. If such road
- 28 lies within a township in a county operating roads on a township basis,
- 29 the road shall not be vacated or abandoned unless an offer has been made
- 30 to relinquish to the township in the manner provided in section 39-1726.
- 31 (3) In the event that the county board decides to vacate or abandon

- 1 a public road, its resolution shall state upon what conditions, if any,
- 2 the vacation or abandonment shall be qualified and particularly whether
- 3 or not the title or right-of-way to any vacated or abandoned fragment or
- 4 section of road shall be sold, revert to private ownership, or remain in
- 5 the public. If the county board fails to specify in a resolution as to
- 6 the disposition of right-of-way, and if there shall be nonuse of such
- 7 right-of-way for any public purpose for a continuous period of not less
- 8 than ten years, the right-of-way shall revert to the owners of the
- 9 adjacent real estate, one-half on each side of such road thereof.
- 10 (4) When the county vacates all or any portion of a road, the county
- 11 shall, within thirty days after the effective date of the vacation, file
- 12 a certified copy of the vacating resolution with the register of deeds
- 13 for the county to be indexed against all affected lots.
