- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>(1) For purposes of this section, educational</u>
2	decisionmaker has the same meaning as in section 79-530.
3	<u>(2) Each school board of a public school district shall adopt a</u>
4	policy for implementation at the beginning of the 2026-27 school year,
5	<u>relating to the rights of a parent, guardian, or educational</u>
6	decisionmaker to access school library materials. Such policy shall:
7	<u>(a) Require the creation of an online catalog of all books in the</u>
8	school district's library, categorized by school building, which shall be
9	<u>accessible for viewing by a parent, guardian, or educational</u>
10	decisionmaker of a student attending such school district; and
11	<u>(b) Provide the opportunity for a parent, guardian, or educational</u>
12	<u>decisionmaker of a student to be notified when the student of such</u>
13	parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker checks out a book from the
14	school library by means of a website or application notification or by
15	opting in to email notifications. Such notification shall include:
16	(i) The title of the book checked out by the student;
17	(ii) The name of the author of the book checked out by the student;
18	and
19	<u>(iii) The date the book checked out by the student is due to be</u>
