 Impaired; to amend section 71-8616, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska; to provide for development of a statewide support service
 provider program for deaf-blind persons; to state intent regarding
 appropriations; to eliminate obsolete provisions; to repeal the
 original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-8616, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

71-8616 (1) The commission shall develop a statewide support service 3 provider program for deaf-blind persons that facilitates a transition 4 from dependency to independent living and participation in society. All 5 6 property, equipment, supplies, and personnel which belonged to, were 7 allocated to, or were used to support the Division of Rehabilitation 8 Services for the Visually Impaired within the Department of Health and 9 Human Services prior to July 1, 2000, are transferred to the Commission 10 for the Blind and Visually Impaired.

11 (2) The program shall include, but not be limited to, (a) assistance 12 to live independently, (b) access to visual, situational, and 13 environmental information, (c) services of a human guide, (d) 14 facilitation of brief, casual exchanges of spoken or signed 15 conversations, and (e) assistance with daily living activities such as 16 transportation to and from appointments, reading and sorting mail, and 17 recipes and food labeling.

18 (3) The commission may contract with a private provider or may offer
 19 the services directly through the program.

(4) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate one hundred
 thousand dollars from the General Fund for fiscal year 2025-26 and one
 hundred thousand dollars from the General Fund for fiscal year 2026-27 to
 the commission for the statewide support service provider program.

(2) All existing contracts and agreements in effect on July 1, 2000,
 as to the Division of Rehabilitation Services for the Visually Impaired
 within the Department of Health and Human Services are binding and
 effective upon the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired.
