- 2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:
- 3 **Section 1.** At the general election in November 2026, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To amend Article III, section 12:
- 7 **III-12** (1) No person shall be eligible to serve as a member of the
- 8 Legislature for four years next after the expiration of <u>three</u> two
- 9 consecutive terms regardless of the district represented.
- 10 (2) Service prior to January 1, 2001, as a member of the Legislature
- 11 shall not be counted for the purpose of calculating consecutive terms in
- 12 subsection (1) of this section.
- 13 (3) For the purpose of this section, service in office for more than
- 14 one-half of a term shall be deemed service for a term.
- 15 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 16 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 17 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- A constitutional amendment to change the limit on legislative terms
- 19 from two consecutive terms to three consecutive terms.
