The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB166 amends current law to require the county treasurer to publicly withhold the residential address of any member of law enforcement, the National Guard or a judge who applies to the county assessor to have his or her address withheld. Current statute requires that the county assessor and the county register of deeds to publicly withhold the address of those who apply under current law to have their address publicly withheld for a period of 5 years. Since county treasurers are not currently required to comply with the statute, the addresses of members of law enforcement, and the National Guard, and judges are readily accessible by clicking on the treasurer online link on the county assessor website.
