LB 525 relates to the State and Political Subdivisions Tort Claims Acts. LB525 limits first party insurance companies and other obligators' ability to seek subrogation from the state or political subdivisions for amounts owed for property damage caused by a vehicular pursuit.

The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) indicates LB525 has the potential to save on the liability of the State for property damages regarding innocent third parties as a result of vehicular pursuits. The amount of the potential savings cannot be estimated.
