This bill would change provisions relating to confiscation and destruction of firearms.

This bill allows an owner to collect court costs, damages of at least one thousand dollars, and reasonable attorney's fees in any legal action required to recover a firearm confiscated by a law enforcement agency if the owner prevails. This could increase expenditures of the state and political subdivisions. The fiscal impact is indeterminate at this time because it is unknown how many persons would be impacted by this provision of the bill.

The State Patrol estimates no fiscal impact from the provisions of this bill.

**IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS:** The Lancaster County Sheriff states that they have an interlocal agreement with the Lincoln Police Department regarding the storage and disposition of property and evidence so any fiscal impact would affect the Lincoln Police Department. The Legislative Fiscal Office analyst (LFO) sent this bill out late to Lincoln so they did not have time to respond. If LFO receives a response from Lincoln, then this fiscal note will be updated.
