In the context of public building commissions (cities and counties), LB480 technically amends the definition of the term "project" to include fixtures and furnishings if agreed to by the city and county. The bill also provides that public building commission agreements with a city or county, or both, as to the operation, maintenance, repair and use of public building commission projects may provide that the city or county, or both, has responsibility for a certain area within any building, structure, or facility, including the maintenance, repair, use, furnishing or management of the area. The bill represents no definitive fiscal impact to affected political subdivisions. Any related impacts would be dependent upon the actions of political subdivisions acting under authority granted by the bill.
