Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 500 changes provisions related to school buses. The bill repeals current law requiring school bus drivers in a city or village to have at least 400 feet of clear vision when a bus stops to unload pupils. The requirement is retained for drivers outside of a city or village.

The State Department of Education will need to revise a rule to reflect the elimination of the requirement for bus drivers in cities and villages. The estimated cost for rule revision is \$600. It is assumed the department can handle the revision with existing resources of the agency.
