**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB 512 pertains to academic content standards and state assessments. The bill allows the State Board of Education to modify standards and administer assessment instruments that measure student knowledge relative to common academic content standards adopted by a consortium of states in particular subject areas.

The board currently has the authority to adopt academic content standards and select assessment instruments. The bill allows the board to modify standards as it deems appropriate, use standards developed by a consortium of states, and administer assessments to measure knowledge of these standards. The authority to use different standards and assessment instruments does not have a fiscal impact for the state unless the changes to the assessment system allowed by the bill result in the use of a more expensive assessment instrument. It is assumed the bill will have no fiscal impact because any modifications to the assessment system pursuant to the bill will need to be made with resources available to the department.
