Section 7 requires the creation of an election day voter registration pilot project beginning October 1, 2015. Counties may apply to participate in the project if they submit a written application to the Secretary of State. Section 7 also creates the Election Day Registration Pilot Project Task Force to study and make a recommendation to the Legislature on or before December 31, 2018 regarding whether to implement election day voter registration on a permanent statewide basis.

The Secretary of State estimates no fiscal impact.
