LB 611 amends Nebraska Revised Statutes, Section 4-114, dealing with new employee work eligibility requirements.

The bill would require private employers to register with and use the federal immigration verification system to determine the work eligibility status of new employees working in Nebraska.

A civil penalty of \$2,000 is imposed on any employer who violates this requirement.

The bill has an operative date of January 1, 2016.

The Department of Labor indicates no fiscal impact as a result of LB 611.

We agree with the Department of Labor's estimate of fiscal impact.
