Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

Current law requires counties that have adopted a comprehensive development plan and are enforcing subdivision regulations to approve plans for planned unit developments to be located in the extraterritorial zoning jurisdictional area of cities of the second class and villages which are located in the related counties. LB875 would eliminate this approval requirement for counties with a population of 100,000 to 200,000 (i.e. Sarpy); however, such plans would be required to be submitted to the related county for review. The bill appears to represent no definitive fiscal impacts as it relates to the relevant political subdivisions.
