Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 418 increases the amount that may be imposed as a civil penalty by the Superintendent of Law Enforcement and Public Safety against motor carriers transporting persons or property in interstate commerce for various violations. The State Patrol indicates the increase in the fine for violations of subsection (1) of Section 75-369.03 will increase annual revenue by about \$110,000 based upon violations in the last calendar year. The current penalty is a maximum of \$500. The bill increases the maximum penalty by \$300, to a total of \$800. The revenue accrues to the county where the violation occurs, for use by public schools. The other changes in penalties in the bill may have a minimal, if any, increase in revenue because violations are rarely cited.
