**Explanation of Estimate:**

The Agency has deemed this proposal to have no fiscal impact if approved. The Agency has not utilized the condemnation statues for many years and is not currently conducting any condemnation proceedings. As such, there have not been any recent expenses associated with this process. If however, a condemnation proceeding were to occur there would be a large amount of deputy work time associated to the inspection, order writing and court testimony that would be required. While the deputy is already on staff, it would take time away from other assigned duties. Further, the Agency could have to hire an auctioneer to conduct the required auction to ensure all rules regarding the auction are met. Also, based on the reason for the condemnation the Agency may need to hire a structural engineer to evaluate the property, make recommendations regarding the condemnation, and testify in court in regards to the findings. The amount of these costs is unknown.
