LB 230 creates the Nebraska Economic Development Advisory Committee. The committee consists of nine members of which 7 are state legislators and 2 agency directors. The duties are to gather input on economic development issues. The committee is to meet on or before June 15 of each year and then every three months, a total of four times per year. There would be a cost for these meetings with respect to mileage and other expenses for legislators. However these travel costs could already be incurred for any other duties as a legislator and are budgeted as such and not shown as additional costs attributed to the bill.
