LB 820 eliminates the requirement for inspection of traveling portable amusement rides.

Currently all inspections of amusement rides are performed by Department of Labor elevator inspectors. The Department of Labor reports that the inspection of traveling amusement rides is time intensive and has had a negative impact on the ability of the elevator inspectors to accomplish the required inspections of elevators and escalators throughout the State in a timely manner.

The Department estimates ongoing cost savings of approximately \$7,665 of travel and overtime costs per year.

The Department also estimates a \$29,380 loss in Amusement Ride Inspection revenue, but an increase of \$45,000 in Elevator Inspection revenue for a net revenue gain of \$15,620 per year.
